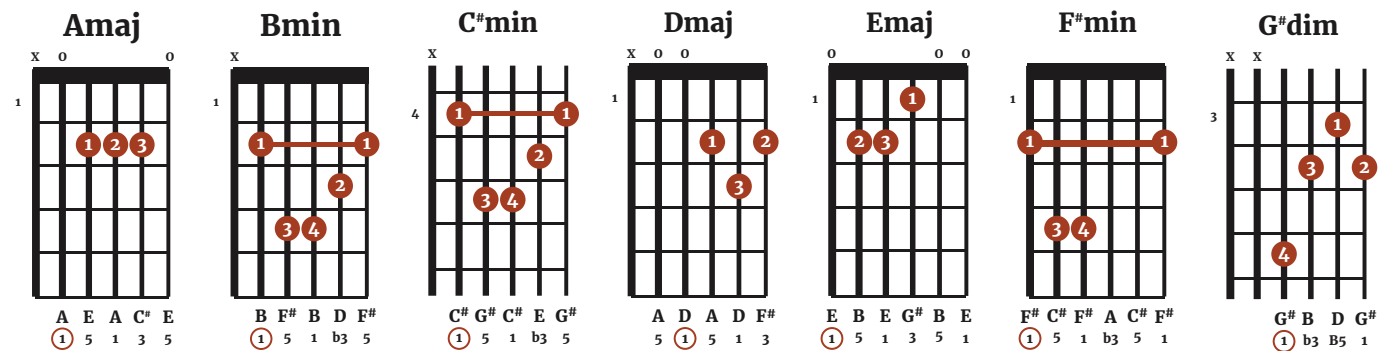
The A Major Scale
